

DIRECTIONS

From Shaw-Howard Univ. Metro Station - Green Line

Exit the Shaw-Howard U. Metro station from the 7th Street/Georgia Avenue entrance, turn right/north and proceed approximately six blocks until you have reached the main campus of Howard University.

From Virginia - Traveling North

Take I-95 to I-395 to the 12th Street exit. Turn right onto Constitution Avenue. Follow Constitution Avenue to 7th Street and turn left. Follow 7th Street (at Florida Avenue, 7th street becomes Georgia Avenue) to Howard Place (approximately four blocks from Florida Avenue) and turn right.

From Maryland - Traveling South

Take I-95 to I-495 (Silver Spring). Take I-495 to Georgia Avenue (Silver Spring). Take Georgia Avenue to Howard Place (approximately seven miles). Turn left. You are now on the campus of Howard University.

Jayne Shepherd, MS, OTR/L, FAOTA is an Associate Professor, Assistant Chair and the Director of Academic Fieldwork at Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia. Prior to teaching at VCU, Jayne supervised and coordinated occupational therapy and special education fieldwork students. She has managed the Fieldwork I program at VCU for 22 years and FW II for the past 4 years. As a trainer for the AOTA Fieldwork Educator Certification Program and as a member of the Virginia Occupational Therapy Fieldwork Council, she has networked with many fieldwork educators to bridge academia and practice. Jayne has several professional certifications, co-authored a book on school-based practice, and has written numerous articles and book chapters. As a keynote, Jayne will integrate her experience as an educator and practitioner with information obtained from the recent Fieldwork Educator Survey sent to educators.
